WELCOME



We are delighted to be hosting Europe's best canoe slalom paddlers once again in Ljubljana in May in the famous Kayak Centre Tacen. The 2024 ECA I Feel Slovenia Canoe Slalom European Championships will be the first major international canoe slalom competition of the Olympic season 2024.

Tacen is a venue with a long tradition of hosting major canoeing competitions. This will be the third time that the Championships of the Old Continent will be held on the Sava River. The first time the canoe slalom paddlers competed for the European Champion titles was in 2005, and once again the European titles were contested in 2017. Ljubljana also hosted a number of World Cup races, Junior and U23 Canoe Slalom World Championships, and three Senior World Championships.

The devastating floods that hit Slovenia in 2023 also destroyed the Kayak Centre Tacen, which was almost wiped out, almost all infrastructure was destroyed, and much of the equipment was swept away, causing enormous damage to the Canoe Federation of Slovenia.

The venue will be repaired by May, when the European Championships will take place, in extent to host the Championships, and after the Championships we plan a complete reconstruction, which should give back the much-needed infrastructure for the training and education of young athletes to one of the most successful Slovenian sports.

The 2024 ECA I Feel Slovenia Canoe Slalom European Championships will be the biggest sporting event in Slovenia this year, and TV coverage of the competition will be available in many European countries.

In addition to the sporting peak, the upcoming Canoe Slalom European Championships will also have a strong charitable note, as the Canoe Federation of Slovenia will donate the entire proceeds from ticket sales of the European Championships to co-finance the reconstruction of Kayak Centre Tacen which was destroyed in the floods.

The Canoe Federation of Slovenia and the Organising Committee of the 2024 ECA I Feel Slovenia Canoe Slalom European Championships - Tacen 2024 are pleased to invite all national teams and competitors to the Championships, as we are confident that we will witness a top-class sporting event.

- Nominal entries close: 6th May 2024
- · Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

REMINDER

• Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the event organiser will NOT be accepted.

PARTICIPATION FEE

The Participation fee will be charged per each athlete and team official for the Access Period, 11th – 19th May 2024. The amount of the Participation fee is 160 € for the Access Period.



COMPETITION RULES

The 2024 ECA I Feel Slovenia Canoe Slalom European Championships will be run in accordance with the 2023 ICF Canoe Slalom competition rules and modifications approved by the ECA Board of Directors.

DIFFERENCES FROM THE ICF RULES

Entries:

Each NF can enter three (3) boats per Canoe Kayak events and Kayak Cross events. The defending European Champion may be entered by their NF in addition to the 3 boats mentioned above. The defending Champion will be identified by wearing a special bib, with the words "European Champion 2023".

New medal event:

The programme will be extended to include Kayak Sprint Cross as a medal event.

ATHLETE'S VILLAGE

Athlete's village will include private tent for each participating team. Toilets will be available in the village.

INTERNET ACCESS

High Speed Wireless internet access will be available at the venue – the competition area, all office spaces, including ECA offices, Jury, Accreditation office and Media Centre.

ACCESS PASS AND PARKING

Free access pass and car parking near the athlete's village will be guaranteed for up to two accredited vehicles.

OFFICIAL VIDEO SERVICE

Technical video signal will be provided during the competition days and all demonstrations runs. Only a download solution will be available. Each national tent will be equipped with their own download cable. Each NF needs to bring its own 20m LAN cable.

BOAT STORAGE

Boat storage racks will be placed near athlete's village.

FIRST AID

A small tent with first aid will be located in the finish area. The NF will advise all participants that emergency medical services will cover only emergency cases and that all participants are responsible to arrange medical insurance policy at their own cost.

WATER SAFETY

Rescuing in the competition area will be organised during the competition days.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Organising Committee kindly asks all participants of the 2024 ECA I Feel Slovenia Canoe Slalom European Championships to ensure medical insurance policy in their respective countries. All costs above the regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by this medical insurance policy. Organising Committee will not cover any expenses in connection with hospital treatment.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be performed in accordance with the ICF/ECA Anti-doping requirements and WADA standards.

ANTI-DOPING EDUCATION PROGRAMME

SUSTAINABLE ORGANISATION OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

As part of the 2024 ECA I Feel Slovenia Canoe Slalom European Championships we will dedicate a special attention to sustainable organisation. VISA INFORMATION slovenian visa requirements

ACCESS AND TRANSPORT

Teams should provide their own transport of competitors and equipment. Teams which would require assistance with transportation from the airport to the venue and vice versa can gain necessary information from the organiser. Transport provided by the organiser will be extra charged. Please note, Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport – Brnik (Slovenia) is the official airport of the competition.

ARRIVING BY CAR

Slovenia has a good road infrastructure. Ljubljana is located at the crossroads of the country's most important road routes. For driving on motorways, it is mandatory for you to have a vignette (including the motorway ring road around Ljubljana). LJUBLJANA CITY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The Ljubljana City Transport (LPP - <u>http://www.lpp.si/en/public-transport/map-bus-</u> <u>routes-and-p-r</u>) has lines that have bus stops close to the venue. You must enter the bus through the front door and activate special Urbana public transport card (or Urbana mobile app) in machine next to the driver. To get to the venue from the city centre take the line 8 – direction Gameljne (Monday – Saturday) and line 1B – direction Gameljne (Sundays and Holidays only).

On competition days, the Ljubljana City Transport (LPP) transfers on the lines towards Tacen are free of charge with accreditation or tickets for the competition.
