## Travel information





Paris-Charles-de-Gaulle International Airport, located in Roissy-en-France, is the **leading French airport**, the 2nd European hub and **10th worldwide** in terms of passengers.

More than a hundred airlines operate from Paris-Charles-de-Gaulle airport, serving around 330 destinations in nearly 120 countries.



The airport attracts international customers to the Seine-et-Marne department.



#### By train Direct access to the cities

The department has 2 TGV stations at Roissy and Chessy. They provide direct access to train lines, RER and even to Roissy airport. These stations serve French and European destinations.







The Seine-et-Marne railway network has a total of more than **80 stations** throughout the region, which are served by **4 RER lines** (A, B, D, E) as well as **3 transiliens lines** (K, P, R) with direct links to Paris.



## A network developed for all users

The road network in Seine-et-Marne reflects the good accessibility of the region and is the primary means of travel for users.

The main routes (215 km of motorways and 196 km of national roads), mainly directed towards Paris, are complemented by a fairly dense network that favours local services. Numerous inter-city bus lines provide public transport services in the area, particularly the 14 Seine-et-Marne Express lines.







The 80-hectare Vaires-sur-Marne lake was built in the late 1980s on the foundations of former quarries to host the 1991 Sprint World Cup.

The venue is already famous because of the 2024's Olympic Games and is also a beautiful green space where local people can come to walk and enjoy the associated sports facilities.

#### Athletes access to the competition site: PARKING (page 11)

The organizing committee asks each nation to come and deposit their material in the athletes' village (zone 4). This area will be secured throughout the competition. Boat racks will also be installed.

The nations' car will have to be parked on the parking at the entrance of the competition site (zone 8).

#### Public access to the competition site: PARKING/TICKETING

The spectator capacity is 6 000 people only on the left side of the course with a green and comfortable space. A parking area will be set up for the public on and around the competition site.





## Technical aspects of the course

#### Competition course:

• Length: 300 meters

• Width: 14 meters

• Drop: 4,5 meters

• Water flow: 13 m3

• 50-meter conveyor belt system

Training course: 200-meter, warm-up and cool-down area.

#### Other training possibilities

- Chelles white-water stadium (6km/15 minutes by car)
- Cergy-Pontoise white-water stadium (68 km/1h30 by car)





## Event & Competition schedule

#### Official training

The competition venue will be open to all the European Federations and secured from the Saturday 10<sup>st</sup> May 2025 to Sunday 18th May 2025.

Participating National Federations will have access to official trainings from Saturday 10<sup>st</sup> May to Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> May as follows:

- 1 slot of training per day and per nation for slalom
- 1 slot of training per day for kayak cross
- 25 to 30 boats per group
- The organisers will set different courses slalom training each day.
- The kayak cross course will be set for each day of training but may be tuned slightly during the period.

- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

## Entries & participation fee



#### Participation fee

The Participation fee will be charged per each athlete and team official for the Access Period, 10<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> May 2025.

The amount of the Participation fee is 160 € for the Access Period.

The participation fee will include the following services: Athlete's Village, Official video service, Boat storage, Security, Internet Access, Access pass and parking, Information regarding the accommodation, Free training period, First aid, water safety during period competition, Flat-water training, Invitation letter for VISA applications.

The accreditation fee must be paid in advance by 8<sup>th</sup> May 2025 via bank transfer to make the accreditation process more convenient.

**Reminder:** Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee, or the competition organiser will NOT be accepted.

## **VISA Requirements**





France is a state-member of the European Union. The French Embassy in your country will provide you with all detailed information about visas. You will find details in the website on French Foreign Affairs Ministry (<a href="http://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/">http://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/</a>).

Please inform in advance but no later than **10<sup>th</sup> March 2025** the Organising Committee together with the visa form whether your team needs entry visas to France.

# Special regulation in France



#### Evin laws (N. 91-32 January 10th 1991)

 This law forbids advertising of all alcoholic beverages (any level of alcohol including beer) and tobacco inside sports arenas (canoe slalom stadium is a sport arena). No advertising on tracksuits, boats, paddles ...

#### Protection of athlete health law (N. 99-223 March 23rd 1999)

Specific doping regulations on French territory.

# Insurance, Medical care and Anti-Doping



#### First Aid

First aid for countries will be located between flat water area and slalom course (n°34) from 10<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> May. The NF advise all participants that emergency medical services will cover only emergency cases and that all participants are responsible to arrange medical insurance policy at their own cost.

#### Water safety

Rescuing in the competition area will be organised only during the competition days. Countries are responsible of their athletes during training period. However, there always will be someone in HOC office (n°9) to help contacting first aid or emergency if needed.

#### Medical insurance

The Organising Committee kindly asks all participants of the 2025 ECA Canoe Slalom European Championships to arrange medical insurance policy in their respective countries. All costs above the regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by this medical insurance policy. The Organising Committee will not cover any expenses in connection with hospital treatment.

#### Doping Control

Doping control will be performed in accordance with the ICF/ECA Anti-doping requirements and WADA standards.



# Insurance, Medical care and Anti-Doping



#### **Anti Doping Education**

For the ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and Continental Championships, every athlete, coach and support personnel MUST pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role

Athletes entered in any ICF competition or Continental championships must complete the ICF's anti-doping education programme or equivalent before competing or risk being denied entry to the competition. For more information please see: https://www.canoeicf.com/anti-doping-education
