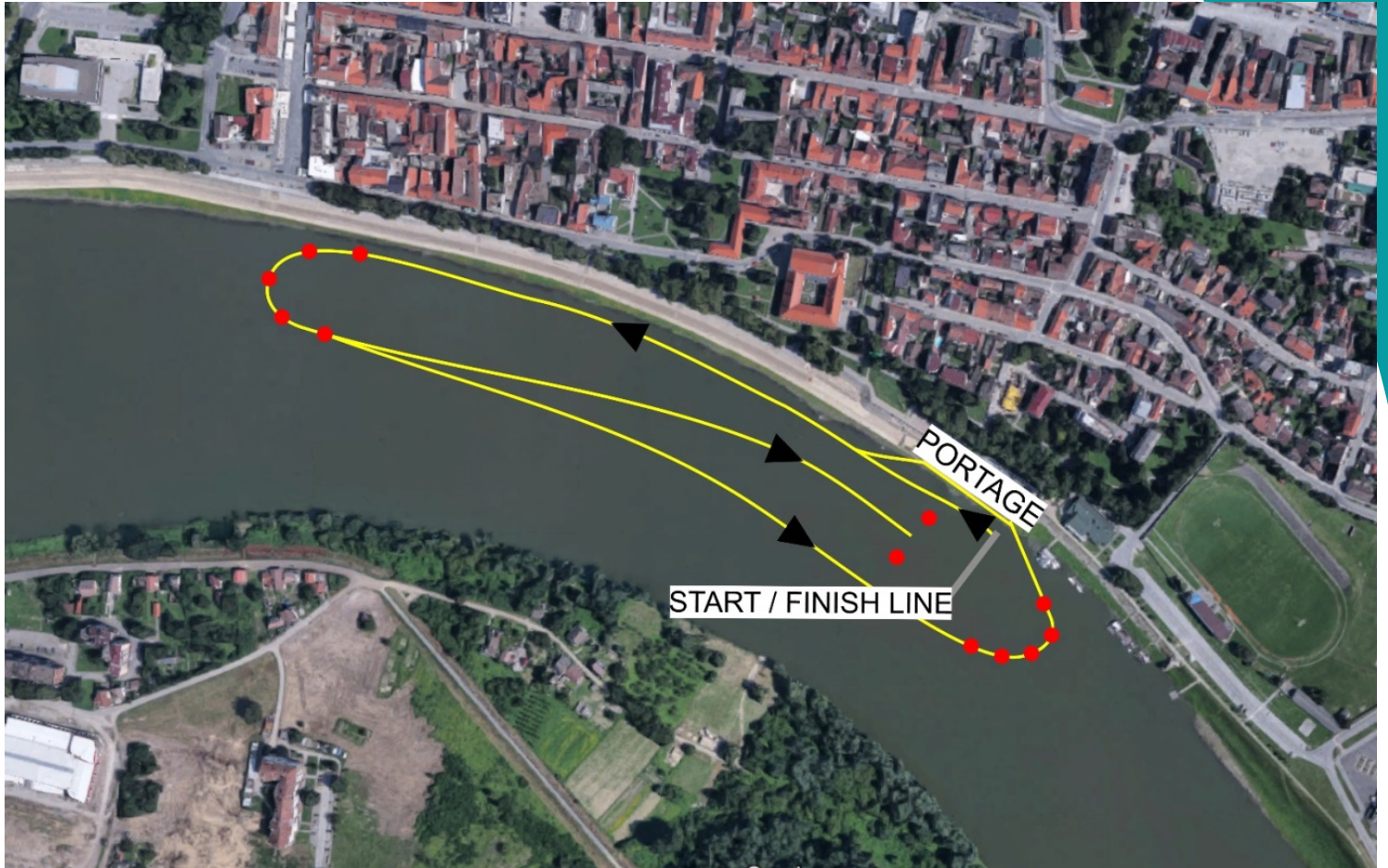

PARTICIPATION FEE

Only for those who have not booked accommodation with the organiser.

Participation fee of **20 € per day** is payable for the days during the access period excluding lunch.

The participation fee includes the following:

- **Accreditation**
- **Medical Care at the Course**
- **Participation in the Opening Ceremony**
- **Security Service at the Course**
- **Access pass and parking the venue**
- **Organisation Fee**
- **Drinking water during competition days**
- **Transport to hotel and course included (only for booked accommodation through organization).**
- **Access to the competition venues for the purpose of training and other activities.**
- **Outdoor boat storage**
- **Free Wi-Fi at the competition venues**

The participation fee is calculated from the time of the arrival of the sports team, until the team leaves.

Participation fee FOR MASTERS

- 1 race 60,00 €
- 2 races 75,00 €
- 3 races 90,00 €

ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND RATES:

Airport pick-up service from (Zagreb) Franjo Tuđman Airport (ONLY) to the venue/hotel upon arrival and from venue/hotel upon departure. Directly agreed with B travel agency (request through Preliminary entry – Google forms).

Lunch tickets will be available for accredited people choosing not to take advantage of the accommodation package at a price of **€ 20 per day/per person from July 10 to July 16** (only when booked in advance).

VISA

BY CAR/TRAIN

Slavonski Brod is an important intersection of major traffic routes in the west-east and north-south directions. So through Slavonski Brod passes the Paneuropean Corridor X railway and the A3 motorway from Western Europe to the Middle East. On the Sava River is the road connecting Croatia and Bosnia and Hercegovina, which is also an international border crossing.

BY AIR

Franjo Tuđman Airport is the largest and most important airport in Croatia. It's located about 170 kilometers west from Slavonski Brod.

EXPERIENCE SLAVONIA

Between the Drava River in the North, the Sava in the South, the Papuk Mountain in the West and the Danube in the East, there lies the breadbasket of Croatia.

MUSEUM OF TAMBURA

Visit the world's first museum of tambura in the reconstructed casemate of the western curtain in the Brod Fortress where you can see more than 60 handmade exhibits.



MALENA AND KLEPETAN

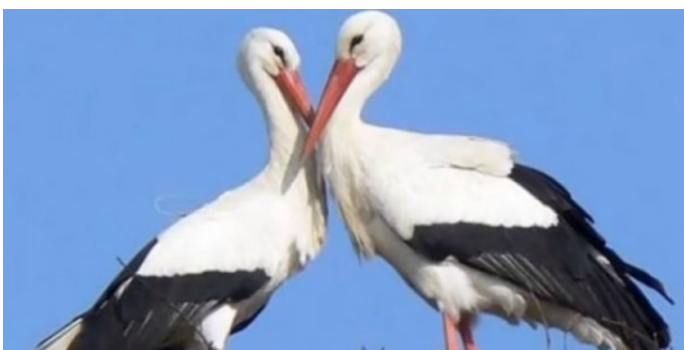
Malena and Klepetan are storks that nest on the roof of the school in the settlement Brodski Varoš. Malena has a broken wing, so she has been waiting for March for 10 years when her stork man Klepetan returns from the far south. It was one of the most beautiful love stories followed worldwide as Malena died in 2021.

LAKE PETNJA

The artificial lake "Petnja" is located on the southern slopes of Dilj, 3,5 km northeast of Sibinj, 7 km northwest of Slavonski Brod. The lake itself encourages visitors with its appearance, surrounding forests, forest trails, recreational potentials for fishing, rowing and other water sports in the open air. The special attraction of this lake is blue colour of the water, with the green and brilliant colours of the surrounding forests, which earned the lake the name "Dilj eye".

KOPAČKI RIT

Known as "the Amazon of Europe", the ever-changing Kopački rit is Danube's largest inner delta. This natural wetland reserve is situated between the Danube in the east and Drava in the south, and is one of the most well-preserved floodplains.
