



ECA WILDWATER CANOEING RULES

DIFFERENCES FROM ICF WILDWATER CANOEING RULES

Version 2020-1 / Published on March 2020

At the ECA European Wildwater Canoeing Championships (seniors, juniors and U23) ICF rules for the organization of the World Championships (seniors, juniors and U23) apply, except for the rules further explained in this document.

Organisation

ECA Wildwater Canoeing Championships in Classic and Sprint will be held every odd year.

ECA Junior and U23 Championships in Classic and Sprint will be held every even year.

To be recognised as the European Championships minimum of 5 national teams must start in each event.

Entries

Each national federation can enter up to 4 boats in each individual event and up to 1 team in each team event.

ECA Wildwater Canoeing Championships should be organized during four days.

Nominal entry deadline: 10 days before the first day of competition.

Entries and accreditation requests must be made by the National Federation using the ICF's online entries system (SDP):

Late entries will be accepted if NF inform technical delegate officially by email till Monday before first day of competition.
Organiser will charge a late entry fee of 100€ / per boat.

Start Order European Championships:

The start order of the first individual event will be the reverse order of classification by Federation at the previous Wildwater Canoeing European Championship. Unclassified cases start at the beginning of the list.
The start order of the second individual event will be the reverse order of the results of the first individual event.

Officials

Jury consists of 3 persons, President and two members, which are appointed by the ECA Board of directors. One of the members will be from the organizing Federation. If not all three members are appointed, two appointed ECA Jury members will select the third member of the Jury from the team leaders or NF representatives present at the event.

Technical Officials for the European Championships will be selected by the ECA WWC technical delegate from the group nominated by NFs until January 15th in the year of the Championships.

Travel expenses for selected International Technical Officials (ITO's) will be covered by their NF.

The expenses (room and board) for all International Technical Officials during the competition period are the responsibility of the Organising Federation.

The expenses for travel, room and board for ECA Jury members, ECA technical delegate are the responsibility of the Organising Federation.
