HISTORY

- .The story of canoe sprint begins in the early 20th century when canoeing first emerged as a popular water sport in Europe.
- .Early European canoe races were informal and often held as part of local festivities.
- .The turning point for canoe sprint came in 1936 when it was included in the Berlin Olympics.
- .This marked the formal recognition of the sport on the international stage.
- .After World War II, canoe sprint gained momentum as nations focused on rebuilding and fostering international cooperation.
- .European countries played a crucial role in developing the sport's infrastructure and competition standards.

MAIN EVOLUTIONS

- .In the 1950s and 1960s, Eastern European countries, particularly the Soviet Union, Hungary, and East Germany, began dominating canoe sprint competitions.
- .Their systematic approach to training and state support led to an era of unparalleled success.
- .The latter half of the 20th century witnessed significant technological advancements in canoe design and paddle materials.
- .European nations were at the forefront of these innovations, giving their athletes a competitive edge.
- .As the sport grew in popularity, more European nations embraced canoe sprint, leading to increased competition.
- .The European Canoe Association (ECA) played a pivotal role in organizing regional events and fostering collaboration among nations.
- .The sport faces challenges such as balancing tradition with modernization, ensuring fair competition, and expanding its global footprint.
- .European nations have got the opportunity to lead in addressing these challenges and shaping the future of canoe sprint.

DEFINITION

- Canoe sprint in Europe refers to a competitive discipline within the sport of canoeing, characterized by the racing of canoes and kayaks over designated distances on flatwater courses. This discipline primarily involves athletes utilizing narrow, streamlined canoes or kayaks and employing a technique of alternating paddle strokes on one side of the boat. The distances covered in canoe sprint events typically range from 200 meters to 1000 meters, with competitors aiming to complete the course in the fastest time possible.
- In Europe, canoe sprint holds significant popularity and is organized at various levels, including local, national, and international competitions. Athletes in this discipline demonstrate a combination of strength, endurance, and technical skill as they navigate their canoes or kayaks through the water, striving for optimal speed and precision. Canoe sprint events are governed by the rules and regulations set forth by European and international canoeing federations, ensuring fair competition and standardized practices across the continent. The sport also serves as a platform for athletes to represent their respective countries in prestigious European championships and global competitions.

DIAGNOSTIC

➤ Important evolution in the discipline

Elevate the discipline

➤ Analyse our European championship

Traditional, well organized, revenue effective, elite athletes resulting to 90% of: best results, host organisers, venues, ITOs, athletes, coaches coming from Europe

➤ Competition venues

Since 1933: 41 venues hosted European Championships, European games, World Championships and Olympic games. Several venues welcomed athletes multiple times.

➤ Organizing countries

Since 1933: 23 countries, some with several different host cities hosted European Championships, European games, World Championships and Olympic games

➤ Judges and officials

European Judges and officials continue to represent the majority at major Canoe Sprint events with a high level of knowledge and experience.

➤ The calendar

The competition calendar is quite busy and not well synchronized, needs cooperation of all disciplines together as well as the constant communication with ICF

➤ The economic model of organizing events

The costs for organisers are increasing from year to year, optimatisation of costs is necessary according to the level of the Championships (Senior&Paracanoe vs Junior&U23)

➤ The hosting fees of the events

Non-existent. If we introduces one it needs to show clearly to host organisers what are their duties and responsibilities but also to which extent ECA can support them and in what way.

➤ The television and streaming broadcast - production, audience –

TV production and distribution of TV rights is high and brings revenue to ECA. Further review of TV requirements is required. Streaming of the ECA Championships is strongly recommended from 1st to last race. Minimum requirements to be drafted according to the level of the Championships (Senior&Paracanoe vs Junior&U23)

➤ The contractualization between the ECA and the organizer

Often late and within the year of the Championships. New format needed and model agreement included in Bidding process

DIAGNOSTIC

➤ Gender equity

Not exactly the same in terms of competition program, goal to be set for 2025-2028; ITOs 50-50 has been reached, Technical committee both genders represented.

➤ The specifications of the events

Existing guidelines and requirements to be reviewed according to the level of the Championships (Senior&Paracanoe vs Junior&U23 vs European Cup)

➤ The event attribution process

Current Bidding process is not clear and transparent, Bidding NFs do not know what they commit to (costs, services, etc.). Canoe sprint still has a high number of Bidding NFs but the goal is to maintain experienced ones and introduce new ones.

➤ The link with other disciplines – calendar, multisports events –

Already integrated with Paracanoe and SUP; also integrated in multisport European Championships and European Games. Open to other disciplines.

➤ The competition program

4 days program with 28 Canoe sprint events and 12 Paracanoe. Too long and a challenge for TV production.

➤ The discipline's training tools for coaches, judges, organizers and volunteers

Very limited sources. Goal to produce further technical instructions, simplify the current ones, create video material as guidance to coaches, ITOs, team leaders, organisers, volunteers

➤ The link with the ICF

Very weak at the moment. Goal to enhance communication on various topics.

➤ The link with the member federations

Elevate the communication even more, clear and direct approach, make us more accessible for questions and sharing ideas

➤ The impact of global warming on the discipline

Canoe competitions are held from often during summer months (June-July-August) thus encountering very high temperatures and humidity in some places which may lead to medical impacts. Optimisation of competition program and measures during competition needed.

➤ The link with leisure practices

Non existing. Goal to connect elite to recreational.

- Well developed discipline
- Well organised competitions
- Well organised and experienced ITOs
- TV broadcast brings revenue

OPPORTUNITIES

- Combined championships – CSP / Paracanoe /SUP / CAM / Canoe Polo /Dragon boat – for example to be sprint and marathon sport together! Short races has a huge potential!
- Keep the traditional format but introduce new more popular, light, cost efficient, environmentally friendly, sustainable mass participation events – European Open Cup series (all age groups), Regional events (neighboring countries), E-sports etc. Introduce Masters age group to the existing format of CSP championships
- Introduce European Ranking system and prize money within new formats
- Better sport presentation! Appeal to media with pre-recorded short stories! Educate the viewers more! Promote athletes as our stars!
- Saving our field of play by joining the Environmental programs
- Cooperation between NFs – sharing experiences and expertise in different areas

WEAKNESSES

- Too long competition program
- Non-transparent Bidding process
- Non constant communication with ICF
- Not coordinated competition calendar with ICF
- Different levels of organisation and TV broadcast
- Limited introduction of new technologies

THREATS

- Losing more quotas (athlete and boat) at the Olympic Games
- The number of Host organizers/Bidders are decreasing
- Costs increasing for Host organisers constantly
- Environment endangerment
- Old-fashioned competition format
- E-sports

OUR ACTIONS

- Maintain the traditional elite status of the discipline by providing best and fair conditions to athletes to train and compete
- Develop tools to scheduling our championships with a goal to enhance Canoe Sprint visibility among other disciplines and within ICF calendar
- Review competition program – base Olympic events with addition of supporting exciting events
- Work closely with ICF on TIP camps and expend to the smaller countries
- Introduce new competition formats – European Cup series (regional, club or otherwise)
- Develop European Ranking – simple and clear – introduce prize money to the best
- Research the e-sports market and identify best conditions
- Develop partnerships deals to help NFs rent boats for ECA championships at affordable costs
- Increase inclusiveness – paracanoe, II races, kids' races, spectators' races
- Approach all organisers and their venues, identify where the support is most needed and explore ways of providing assistance
- Approach and activate or reactivate venues in nations where their athletes are producing best results in Canoe Sprint (i.e. Spain)
- Review all rules and requirements and develop a more diverse set of documents according to different levels of the Championships: 3 levels – Senior&Paracanoe, Junior & U23, European Cup
- Create educational tools – online seminars – video material for athletes, coaches, team leaders, ITOs, organisers
- Establish observers' program for new organisers and technical guides
- Reinforce new tools for ITOs: drones, GPS, online forms, etc.
- Draft simple guidance to organisers and participating team how to be more sustainable and protect environment.
- Story-telling: develop stories about our athletes – make them the stars, coaches, ITOs, volunteers, organisers – people are the most important!
- Develop recognition awards to people involved in Canoe Sprint sport
- Develop proper more direct communication channels with all groups to include their opinion

IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF OUR EVENTS AND CALENDAR

Our strengths & Our Weaknesses

Strengths:

- Experience in organisation of events/ strong quality
- Some venues are super experienced
- Sport presentation is perceived as good
- There are some gaps in the program to incorporate fun races (kids: / legends / specials / ...)

Weaknesses

- Reliant on ICF calendar setting to 'fit in' our ECA program
- Frequent changing of distances and numbers
- Race program too long to be attractive for live broadcast
- Same venues repeating. More diversity would be good
- Imparity and smaller numbers in canoe compared to Kayak
- Organizing EU Champs is expensive
- No real marketing person/strategy to support events

ACTIONS

- Try to make a similar standard in quality for all events, quality level will diversify and is depending on level competition (=> update handbook / guidelines)
- Follow up bidding process and reasons to 'pull out'
- Survey needs to take place after each race
- Clear and early communication with ICF regarding calendar
- Make 1 competition program for a 4-year cycle in EU Champs (Olympic program is base, other races can be added)μ
- Hosting fees can only be introduced when ECA can deliver enough support in exchange share costs, host media, ...)
- Technology should be embraced for presentation, ITO, and communication (GPS/Drones/...)
- Event presentation should be improved with storytelling, fun events, interviews, ...
- Sustainability needs to be taken into account +more communication to athletes (sharing and supporting of sustainability document provided)
- Look into other competitions (i.e. European cup)

- The bidding process

- Consolidate our presence at the Olympic, Paralympic and European Game and the major international events
- Consolidate our international leadership in terms of our results
- Aim for excellence in the organization and media coverage of our events - European Championships - Continental Qualifications and generate more revenues from our events
- Develop the number of nations and athletes in our competitions
- Strengthen cooperation between nations, transborder cooperation

DEVELOP THE PLACES TO PADDLE FOR OUR DISCIPLINE

OUR PRIORITIES

- Increase number of active venues
- Increase quality of venues to maintain same quality across venues
- Help potential organizers to organize events
- Improve sustainability of our venues
- Set standards for venues and equipment
- Ask for feedback from relevant stakeholders about each championships
- Make rental boats more available by making partnerships with boat manufacturers thus optimising costs

ACTIONS

- Create map of all venues across Europe with status and level
- Try to reactivate as much venues as possible
- Send a questionnaire to all NFs, which are not organizing international competition about their possibilities to organize one
- Give potential organizers tools, experiences and guidance to organize events
- Categorize venues based on quality
- Help organizers to improve existing venues to maintain same level of quality
- Test new venues with lower-level competition and then progress up to Seniors
- Share experience with event organization between more experienced and less experienced organizers
- Invite future organizers to competition to learn through Observers program
- Improve environmental aspects of our venues
- Educate organizers, athletes, coaches, etc. about sustainability
- Set different standards for venues and equipment for different level of event
- Set a standard for start systems
- Test new start systems on lower-level competition
- Create survey for teams/athletes, Competition committee and Organizing committee right after the championship to get their feedback

Our strengths

- Experience in organizing canoe sprint events across Europe
- Wide range of established venues
- Many of them have a long history of hosting international events
- Many of them are very well developed
- Established standards for venues for organizing championships

Our Weaknesses

- Not all venues are active
- Not the same quality across venues
- Lack of people who would organize events
- It is very expensive to build brand new venue
- Sustainability of venues

Areas of reflection

- The location of the venues in Europe
- The quality of the venue
- Label the venue according to its quality -- e.g.: 1 to 5 stars –
- The support by ECA to the national projects
- How to develop new venues
- How accompany the federation in the creation of new venues
- Assist the federation for the construction of new venues
- The specifications for the venues to host a championship
- Etc.

GUIDELINES

- Increase the number of sites and nations capable of hosting European championships
- Define an infrastructure and equipment plan and implement a support policy: political, technical, legal for project leaders - Project assistance on opportunity studies -
- Identify and promote the venues
- Improve the quality of the venues
- Define specifications for the sites hosting our championships
- Carry out a map of the sites hosting our championships
- Take global warming and environmental protection issues into account for our competition venues and the organization of our competitions
- Support the projects of national federations
- Facilitate the cooperation between nation – share the venues and organizations -

OUR ACTIONS

- Strengthening Europe's influence as the most experienced continent at global level to demonstrate professionalism and tradition of our sport. Emphasis history of sport itself as well as history as Olympic discipline.
- Support of international races for high-performance competitors, but not on the highest European level
- Create a tool to motivate athletes to be more responsive and reach to ECA in a more direct way
- ECA to connect to already existing coaches course (ICF, NFs, etc.) and support financially or otherwise participation of coaches in those.
- Create education videos for coaches on the rules, or specific to an event – what to do when on the events, who to talk to, what are the competition procedures, etc. As well as education document as well for coaches specific to an event, to a venue.
- Motivate and prepare ITOs for international events and provide growth opportunities, protecting European judges on the world level.
- Educated new ITOs and involve them more, first from Junior level and grow them up to Senior level, ICF level and one day Olympic level competitions. Include and educated more NTOs thus reducing costs but grooming them to become ITOs one day.
- Rethink the process of nomination of ITOS for ECA events.
- Uniting clothing for all types of officials: using of the same ECA uniform across years
- Observers program, creating guidebook and making the Bidding process more clear and transparent.
- Motivating individuals through their gradual personal growth from local, regional, national to European and then a global level
- Organizing training and education camps for different groups of stakeholders: different approaches: individually for positions and also across (every year, every two years, event specific, etc.
- Telling stories about athletes, stakeholders, legends, NFs, national and local clubs, places of important races
- Recognizing individuals and the need for media support to improve the sport's image. Recognise them through story telling, prizes and award (best coach, best athlete, ITO, volunteer, etc.), special vote on social media/competition for achievement other than that results. Need for support from the media department to create content for recognizing individuals.
- Alternative communication platforms and methods to connect the community and recognize contributions. Using social media groups, Using surveys, newsletters and other written means of communication to provide up to date information.

IMPROVE OUR RULES AND REGULATIONS

OUR PRIORITIES

- Maintain the same set of rules as ICF in ECA Championships to grow the sport globally
- Differentiate between different levels of the requirements between different levels of competition (Senior&Paracanoe vs Junior&U23 vs ECA Cup)
- Include our NFs (coaches, athletes) in brainstorming and keep them informed about the rules and regulations changes
- Educate Team leaders, Coaches and Athletes on the rules
- Introduce innovative formats – ECA Cup Series rules and regulations
- Introduce ECA Ranking system
- Competition calendar integration
- Continental Association as such to be recognised within ICF as a stakeholder to propose any rule changes
- Continental Championships as such to be recognised in ICF Rules according the Level of the international competitions.

OUR ACTIONS

- Work more closely with ICF on rules review, make it more clear and simple
- Create different technical requirements according to existing ones (ECA and ICF)
- Ask for feedback of our NFs on a regular basis and define pathway to submit rule changes (as only NFs can submit rule changes according to ICF Statutes)
- Create educational documents and /or videos with simple and clear explanation of the rules
- Define rules for ECA Cup Series
- Define rules on ECA Ranking
- Set guidelines on scheduling ECA events within ECA calendar and cooperate with ICF in an overall calendar placement of events
- Approach ICF and explore the option that Continental associations can propose rule changes also

Keep the same rules and regulations as ICF to grow the sport globally, thus educating our stakeholders: athletes, coaches, officials, organisers!

- Consolidate Technical Committee and define all roles, responsibilities and duties of Technical Chair and each member
- Implement transparent Bidding process for 2028 ECA Championships and beyond including Technical deliverables designed according to the level of competition (Senior&Paracanoe vs Junior&U23) with model Host agreement and hosting fee
- Consolidate competition calendar within ECA in cooperation with other disciplines and ICF for a long-term period
- Review the List of events for the period 2025 -2028 and adapt if any changes in the Olympic program (and ICF).
- Implement the contract with official ECA data service provider 2025-2027 with Service catalogues and Technical requirements to Organisers published
- Maintain presence of European countries in ICF TIP programs and Coaching seminars and open ECA ones
- Evaluation of new race formats – ECA Cup Series (level: regional, club, etc. age groups: junior to masters) and define clear principles
- ECA Rankig series draft and prize money reasearch and define clear prnciples
- Conduct e-sports research and define clear project principles
- Athletes education – user friendly text and video materials on various topic (rules and competition, anti doping education, etc.)
- Coaches education – online seminars, courses, clinics, easily accessible educational material (documents and video) targeted to all level coaches
- ITO education via online seminars, educational material (documents and video)
- Define clear Sport presentation plan
- Liase with ECA Media Manager on Promotioanl plan (storry telling and recognition)
- Liase with ECA TV Director and implement those requirements (TV production vs Live streaming)
