The Kayak Club de Metz is pleased to organize the French slalom championships (masters, C2 and teams) on behalf of the French canoe-kayak federation (FFCK). This event will be composed of a championship dedicated to the MASTERS category and of a Masters slalom European Open on behalf of the European Canoe Association (ECA).


This major event will take place on the weekend of June 29 and 30, 2024. It occurs just after the passing through of the Olympic Flame in Metz.

Over 300 competitors and boats are expected, mobilizing more than sixty volunteers. It will be an opportunity to showcase the city of Metz, canoe-kayak slalom (an Olympic discipline) and the Masters category!

The competition will be held at the heart of Metz, on the Pucelle whitewater stadium at the lie du Saulcy, in a verdant, tree-lined setting that will provide ideal conditions for welcoming a large audience.

We look forward to welcome many of you there and to make this a great sporting event!

The 2024 Olympic Games preparation center at the Pucelle whitewater stadium is in downtown Metz. It is a semi-artificial pool fed all year round by 2 floodgates which are operated by a remote control. It is a national-level facility and accessible to paddlers accredited with at least the "green" paddle.




Athletes who do not have a federal license in their country must subscribe on site to our complementary insurance at a cost of €1.

French athletes registered for the French Masters Championships automatically take part in the European Open, with no additional entry fees.

French athletes not selected for the French Masters Championships may take part in the Masters Open, as long as they have registered for the Open.

RULES

French federal rules and ICF rules apply.









RACE FORMAT

Race formats are subject to change depending on the number of entries.

European Open Masters slalom

The race format is identical to that of the individual masters races at the French Championships. The course is also identical.

Progression:

Qualifications: round 1 / round 2

Final B / final A

The best of the 2 qualifying round is considered for access to the

final A or B.

Final A: top 5 boats in each category

Final B: next boats

Results: European Open ranking, taking into account the ranking order of masters boats of all nationalities in the A final, then those in the B final.

NAVIGATION


Free paddling on Friday June 28th from 10am to 8pm and on Saturday morning depending on the starting time of the races.

Safety on the water:

Safety during training sessions up until the start of the races on Saturday June 29th will be the responsibility of the clubs. The organization will ensure the safety of navigation from Saturday June 29th until the end of the competitions. We ask you to imperatively respect the information which will be communicated to you.

Site security:

Site will be guarded only on Saturday evening.

However, the organizer recommends that you do not leave anything of value in tents, cars or on the competition site. The organizer accepts no responsibility in the event of theft or disappearance of equipment from the site.
