Due to the global sanitary situation, we decided to postpone the European championship 2020 to 2021 in order to fully enjoy and offer a great sporting event in both competition and organizational terms.

Below are the information related to the sanitary conditions that will be put in place during the event. We keep on adapting the organization to be able to welcome you in the best conditions and to make the 2021 edition the Ocean Racing a great moment

#### HEALTH PROTOCOL ON FRENCH TERRITORY : HEALTH PASS.

The pass must prove one of the three following items:

- ✓ That you are fully vaccinated (with an EMA-approved vaccine or similar):
- ✓ Seven days after the second shot for two-shot vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca);
- ✓ Four weeks after the shot for one-shot vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);
- ✓ Seven days after the shot for vaccines administered to people who have already had COVID-19 (only one dose is necessary).
- ✓ OR that you have been tested (PCR or antigen) with a negative result within the last 48hrs;
- ✓ OR that you have recovered from COVID-19, attested by a positive PCR or antigen test result, at least 11 days and no more than 6 months old.

#### ARRIVAL IN FRANCE

**“Green list” countries or territories:** Countries where no active viral circulation has been reported and no relevant variants identified. These are European area countries, plus Albania, Australia, Bahrein, Bosnia, Brunei, Canada, Hong-Kong, Israel, Japan, Jordan, Kosovo, Lebanon, Montenegro, New Zealand, North Macedonia, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Ukraine, the United States, Union of Comoros and Vanua

Upon boarding, each traveller aged 12 and over must present:

- ✓ a complete vaccination schedule (as describe above)
- ✓ a negative PCR or antigenic test taken less than 72 hours.

**If you are travelling from Cyprus, Great Britain, Greece, Spain, the Netherlands or Portugal, your test must be taken less than 24 hours.**

- ✓ If you have previously contracted COVID-19, instead of a negative test result you may present a **certificate of recovery** dated more than 11 days and less than 6 months prior to the date of arrival. A certificate of recovery is a document issued to persons who have contracted COVID-19, upon presentation of a positive RT-PCR or antigenic test.

The organizing committee is concerned about your way back, that’s why the committee is working on suggesting a solution.

## ON SITE

When arriving, you will be kindly asked to provide your address and a contact number.

On Tuesday, 17<sup>th</sup> all the accreditations will be available on the race village from midday – where specific measures will have to be followed.

### WHO IS CONCERNED BY THE HEALTH PASS ON SITE ?

Adults (athletes, coaches, team leaders, etc.). Minors are not required to present a health pass. However, the committee recommends minors to be vaccinated or tested before coming to the competition site.

The health pass must be valid for all the competition and may be checked at any time.

The organisation committee will check the health pass when giving accreditation. Persons with a rt-pcr or antigenic test must present a new test every 48 hours.

In case you fail the health conditions, please report to the accreditation area. The test will be only valid for 48 hours.

## PARTICULAR MEASURES ON SITE

In addition to the health pass, the following measures may apply:

- ✘ Wear a mask throughout the site (surgical or with a filtration level of over 90%)
- ✘ Respect the distance (at least 2 metres)
- ✘ Follow the instructions put in place ( i.e : briefing, prize-giving ceremony, etc)

The only exception is that during the race, wearing a mask is not an obligation.
